It had metastasized and she had several tumors in her brain. The doctors said there was nothing more they could do. She was sent home under hospice care. October 23rd she went home to her savior. Though I missed the children so much, I know that this is where I was supposed to be. I owe so much to my mother. She loved me and supported me all my life. She had a true mother's heart. While she was ill people called from all over the world saying how she was a mother to them and since she has been gone they have called to say how much they will miss her. She has shown me the example of what it means to love people unconditionally. She also gave me her love of adventure. It was difficult seeing her so weak, but through it all God has given our entire family peace that passes all understanding. I am so happy to be back in Nicaragua. I missed the children so much. I spoke to them on the phone as often as possible and tried to keep up with some of the administrative duties from the US via the internet, but it is not the same as being here. Please keep my family, both in the US and those in Nicaragua in your prayers.
