**Update on the solar project.**

We are making great progress on the solar project. The structural assessment has been done, and the structural engineer is currently drawing up the plan for the system. Someone in the US is going to pay for the container to ship the equipment to Nicaragua. The company from whom we are buying the panels is giving us a \$15,000 matching grant for the system. What we need now is to raise the \$15,000. We have currently raised \$2,500. We hope to install the system this March if we get the funding. I believe God will provide. Many of you have written expressing a desire to be on the team that installs the system. I want to let all of you know that we are currently planning on March 2009. I would ask anyone who would like to be on the team to email me. I also have another request. I would like everyone who would like to be part of the team to pledge to raise \$500 towards the project. This can be done with garage sales, bake sales, or any project your imagination can invent. The goal is in sight. Thank you for your help in making this project possible.
